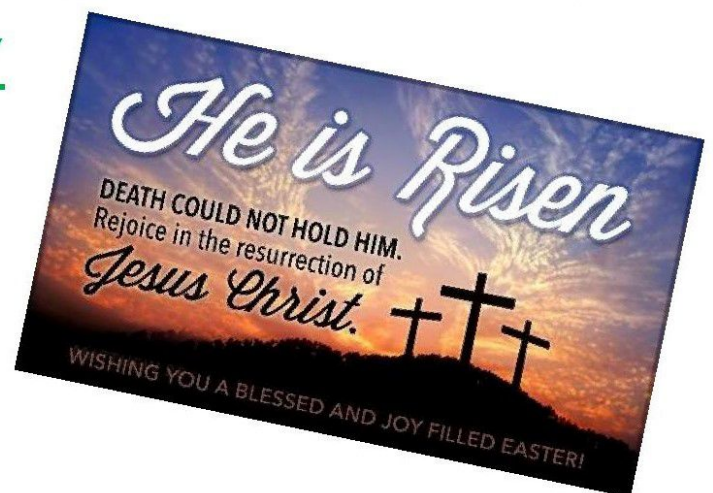

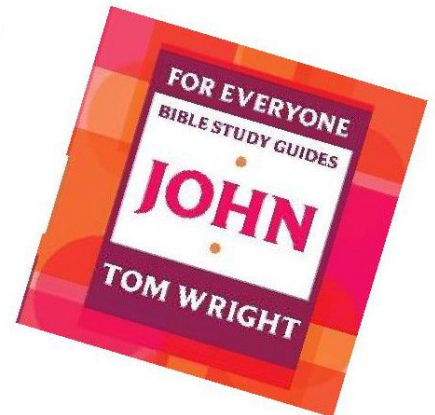

For the 2nd year running, Easter will be “different” this year – not the message, of course, that remains the same no matter what; it’s what we do that will need to be different, as we remain in challenging times. However, this year we are more prepared, having journeyed together through these COVID Times for 12 months now.

So of course, there are the usual Worship Services, Bible Study’s, HouseGroups – all of our usual Outreach Programme remains the same, and is detailed on the middle pages. Then what we have extra are a couple of Initiatives that haven’t been fully finalised yet, and so have not been advertised in-detail – but here they are, in-brief, so that you know what to expect >

1. **LITTER-PICKING** : We are well aware that the Village is becoming more & more untidy, and so we want to encourage everyone to collect the litter from within the vicinity of where they live, as a family bubble of course – even if you don’t live in Silverdale, you’re welcome to join in too! We will be setting aside a certain time over the Easter Weekend where you can come to Church, collect the Litter Picking tools, go & do your own Litter-Pick, and then bring the Litter Picking tools back to Church and claim your free Easter Egg! That is the essence of it, but final details will be announced soon, so keep a look-out.
2. **HYMNS AT HOME** : For all those missing a Traditional style of Worship, or anyone-else that wants to join in, on Easter Saturday (time to be confirmed) Bradley, Nathaniel & Lee will be serenading all those who want to join via ‘Zoom’ with some of the more traditional Easter Hymn Tunes (they may sneak a few more modern ones in too!) on their Brass Instruments. Again, the final details are yet to be confirmed, as they are still to decide where the best place is to actually host the event from (thinking about acoustics!), but it will definitely happen, and will definitely be some time on Easter Saturday. You will get a link for a ‘Zoom’ meeting, and also a SongSheet too so that you can sing-a-long – all will be e-mailed to everyone on our List. Again, the final details will be announced soon, so keep a look-out.

So keep one eye on your e-mails over the next few days, as we will be announcing the final details of both of these Initiatives once they are ready – as well as on Facebook and Instagram; the details will also be added to our Website Calendar. So keep watching, and make sure you try & join in with as much of what we do as you can!
