The Leadership Team's Prayer Meeting, held every Sunday since Oct '20, has evolved further – they now devote the hour, 5pm to 6pm, to personal prayer, **STILL** praying for the Church, and various other matters, but instead of joining together to do it, they do it alone in their own way. They then take what God has said to them during these times to a face-to-face Prayer Meeting on the last Sunday of every month. As a result of this evolution, they would encourage **EVERYONE** to commit to praying – hopefully during the 1-hour from 5pm to 6pm every Sunday, or at some other time during the week if you can't make it then. **We need to commit to praying as a Church**, so that God can continue to guide us into the future, and plan for us, to enable us to continue to build His kingdom in the place where He has called us to serve.

We will be running another 'Alpha Course', beginning some time in September – but we need to saturate it in prayer (there's that need for prayer again!), so that God sends the right people to it, and so that they are open to hearing Him whilst they engage in the Course. So, we are holding two 12hr Days of Prayer, specifically for 'The Alpha Course' – one on the 1st of August, and one on the 31st of August, both from 11am 'til 11pm. So we need people to commit to praying, by signing-up for certain time-slots over the two days – be it half-an-hour, 1-hour, or more, we need you to commit to praying during a certain time. Alternatively, simply let us know what times you will be praying, again via one of the two methods – or some other way if none of those are available to you! – and we will allocate the time-slots to you. A full timetable of names will then be distributed closer to the time – until then, let us know what times you want to commit to, so that you can be included on the timetable. Finally, remember that one of God's commands to us is to pray without ceasing....

Re-election of Church Stewards: John, Elizabeth, Irene

Representatives to church council were nominated and agreed: Richard, Lesley Orrell, LaToya De Freitas, Nathaniel Leighton, Grace Eardley, Dawn Shuffletbotham and Lynda Trotter. Louise Williams was also agreed in anticipation of a positive acceptance of her nomination.

Margaret Hopkin - has shown no commitment to Silverdale Methodist church during the pandemic and was not nominated to continue to be a member of Church Council.

Reports on Ministry and Vision for the Church (Document available. 'Building for the Future'. Lee explained the main points in the document and the changes which will be made, including Live Streaming from the church.

Children and Youth work should begin in September, as should other activities but there is much to think about before these happen. Sunday experiences will come first. Others may return in a new format.

Practicalities of the building. Kitchen only assessable for Leadership Team, as it is unsafe as a working kitchen. Only the disabled toilet will be available.

Refurbishment needs to be undertaken. Rear entrance by the vestry is now decommissioned as more storage space is required. This helps with health and safety. Shutters will remain open and only closed when there are 2 separate activities. A less formal layout for Sunday services, in the church will be introduced.

11am start (background) was explained to Jürgen.

<u>Senior Church Steward Report -</u> Last 15 months unprecedented. This period of time could have been a right off but our report shows that we have continued to worship, care for the community, pastoral care. Zoom has enabled us to continue with events.

Team work of last 15 months has ensured that we continue.

Many thanks to Rev Christine and to Jayne and Lee for all the work that has continued during the pandemic.

Building for the future is exciting. More opportunities to build on the achievements of the last 15 months. 10 new members added to our list. Each member has gifts to contribute. God is faithful and has a plan for us.
