There are some of us who might use the word "chapel" to describe the building, or even us, here at Silverdale – but do we know what the actual meaning of that word is? The Dictionary Definition of the word "chapel" is "..a small building or room used for Christian worship in a school, prison, hospital, or large private house..". The main function of a chapel is to serve as a location for personal prayer or worship within smaller groups. Chapels can be a separate building, and not affiliated with a larger church. A chapel doesn't have a permanent Minister assigned to it. As you can hopefully see, Silverdale Methodist Church is none of these – whilst "chapel" may have been an appropriate word to use in years gone by, it no longer is, as we are not what the definition of "a chapel" is. The building in which we Worship Together is a church, with a lowercase "c", being "..a building used for public Christian worship.." – but remember that we are also, and more importantly, a Church, with a capital "C", being ".. the Church, the REAL Church, the people and not the building..". Words matter, terminology matters, how we describe things matters, so let's make sure that we refer to who & what we are properly at all times, so that we stand a better chance of being understood by everyone, and to ensure that we have the best possible chance of building God's Kingdom in all ways and at all times!
